**Habitat for Humanity is a nonprofit, ecumenical Christian organization dedicated to eliminating substandard housing and homelessness worldwide and to making adequate, affordable shelter a matter of conscience and action.**

So far, Habitat for Humanity has built more than 225,000 houses around the world. There are currently 26 completed homes in Madison and Bond County. Habitat for Humanity offers a hand up, not a hand out to families and neighbors in our communities. There are local Chapters in Wood River, Alton, Collinsville and Greenville.

The Rotary Club of Edwardsville, in partnership with the Wood River Area Habitat Chapter, sponsored and helped build the first Habitat for Humanity house in Edwardsville at 627 Hill Lane. The home was dedicated on October 22, 2007.

A group of volunteers in Edwardsville and Glen Carbon are currently working to formalize a Habitat for Humanity Chapter in the Edwardsville/Glen Carbon area. This local Chapter would be responsible for all future Habitat for Humanity home construction in the Edwardsville/Glen Carbon area.

The initial objective of the Edwardsville/ Glen Carbon Chapter is to build a second home in Edwardsville on Hill Lane by October 2008. A lot on Hill Lane has been donated for a Habitat home. Constructing the home will require the commitment of approximately \$65,000 in cash and goods and services by May 2008. This initial commitment will allow the Chapter to move forward with family selection and site plans.

The initial goal is to formalize the Edwardsville/ Glen Carbon Area Chapter under the umbrella of the Lewis and Clark Habitat Affiliate and to build another home on Hill Lane. The longer-term goal is to build a new home at least every two years.
